Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance / Roll Call

Mayor Stokes called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by Town Clerk Cheryl Aldis. Shown as present were Mayor Russ Stokes, Trustees Brad Stone and Chuck Lanning, Doug Corson, Charmaine Fioretto, and Ben Haier. Trustee Mike Siewierski was absent. A quorum was present.

Approval of Agenda

Trustee Stone moved and Trustee Corson seconded a motion to approve the agenda. Unanimous voice vote carried the motion.

Public Wishing to Speak

There was no one present from the public to speak.

New Business

Job Description for Code Official

Trustee Fioretto moved to approve Code Official Job Description. Trustee Corson seconded. Unanimous voice vote carried the motion.

Comments/Concerns

Trustee Haier commented that the sign for town homes in Robinson Farm has changed.

Trustee Stone reported that they had 826 participants, 68 entries, 9 floats and 15 vendors who participated in the festival and parade. The festival made just shy of \$1,400.00.

Trustee Corson said that the old grade school structure is in sad condition. The owner is still interested in offering part of the building for a community center.

Trustee Lanning reported that the Airport Advisory Board configuration is under review by the City of DeKalb. Cortland currently has a representation. DeKalb is considering not having any representation on the Board.

President Report

Mayor Stokes reported that work is continuing on Cortland Center Road. Fischer Excavating has completed the excavating on Elm Avenue; Peter Baker is to begin early next week with paving. Trees that have been removed in Richland Trail will be relocated and replaced.

Cemetery Report:

Monies from the trust will be set up as a Restricted Assets Fund for cemetery maintenance. With the change in ownership, the cemetery will no longer be covered by the Cemetery Oversight Act.

With no other business to conduct a motion for adjournment was entered by Trustee Haier and seconded by Trustee Fioretto. The meeting adjourned at 7:22 p.m.
