Call to Order/ Pledge of Allegiance/ Roll Call

Mayor Stokes called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call was taken by Deputy Clerk Rita Nielsen. Shown as present were Mayor Russ Stokes, Trustees Brad Stone, Charmaine Fioretto, Chuck Lanning, Ben Haier, Trustee Corson was absent for roll-call, so with the mayor, quorum was present. Trustee Doug Corson (arrived at 7:04.) Trustee Mike Siewierski was absent. Also present were Town Clerk Cheryl Aldis, Public Works Director John Kocher, Police Chief Gary Spangler, and attorneys Kevin Buick.

Approval of Agenda

Mayor Stokes asked that the agenda be amended to remove Executive Session. Trustee Stone moved and Trustee Fioretto seconded the motion to amend agenda with removing executive session. Unanimous voice carried the motion.

Public Wishing to Speak

Charles Black was present and asked to address the board. Mr. Black was representing DC Lightening, a local baseball team. Mr. Black would like to talk about removal or replacing the shed and the possibility of or expanding the field along with some landscaping ideas. Mayor Stokes asked Director Kocher to meet with Mr. Black and bring back requests for consideration.

The Parade & Festival report was submitted to the table. Trustee Stone read the committee report.

President's Report

Mayor Stokes commented on what a busy summer this has been. The only event left for the Town is the Lions Club 5K race and then looking forward to the holidays.

Mayor Stokes asked for a consensus from the trustees as to whether or not he should look into the Town acquiring Mound Rest Cemetery. He explained that the cemetery has always operated under a board of volunteers who have been responsible for maintaining the cemetery grounds. There is a lot of Cortland history in this cemetery and Mayor Stokes is concerned that the possibility of volunteers no longer being able to maintain the cemetery is a concern. Consensus was to move forward with talking with cemetery board and gathering information.
