



New Illinois Pesticide Application Notification Requirements

Town of Cortland residents should be aware of new state regulations regarding pesticide applications on public rights of way that took effect Jan. 1, 2025. Under Public Act 103-0976 (The Pesticide Application on Rights of Way Notification Act), we are implementing enhanced notification procedures to keep our community informed about pesticide applications.

New Notification Requirements for Public Act 103-0976

As of 2025, the Town of Cortland must provide written notice at least 24 hours before any pesticide application to public right of way, including

- Roadways, road shoulders, curbs
- Sidewalks
- Mulch beds
- Other public infrastructure areas

2026 Application Schedule

- Location: Within Town limits
- Season: May 1 through Oct 1, 2026
- Herbicide Time of Application: 7:00am to 3:30pm
- Purpose: To control growth of unwanted vegetation

Locations

- Mulch beds in all parks and Town owned facilities
- Sidewalks along Somonauk Road
- Guard rails at Somonauk And Barber Green Road
- Wastewater Reclamation and Reuse Facility

The following herbicide will be used

Roundup Quikpro SC Total Herbicide: For post emergent weed control

Indaziflam 0.089%

Diquat Dibromide 0.890%

Glyphosate Isopropylamie Salt 20.460%

Other Ingredients 78.561%

Mix rate 16floz per gallon of water

EPA Reg # 432-1532

Instructions: Stay off area until dry
